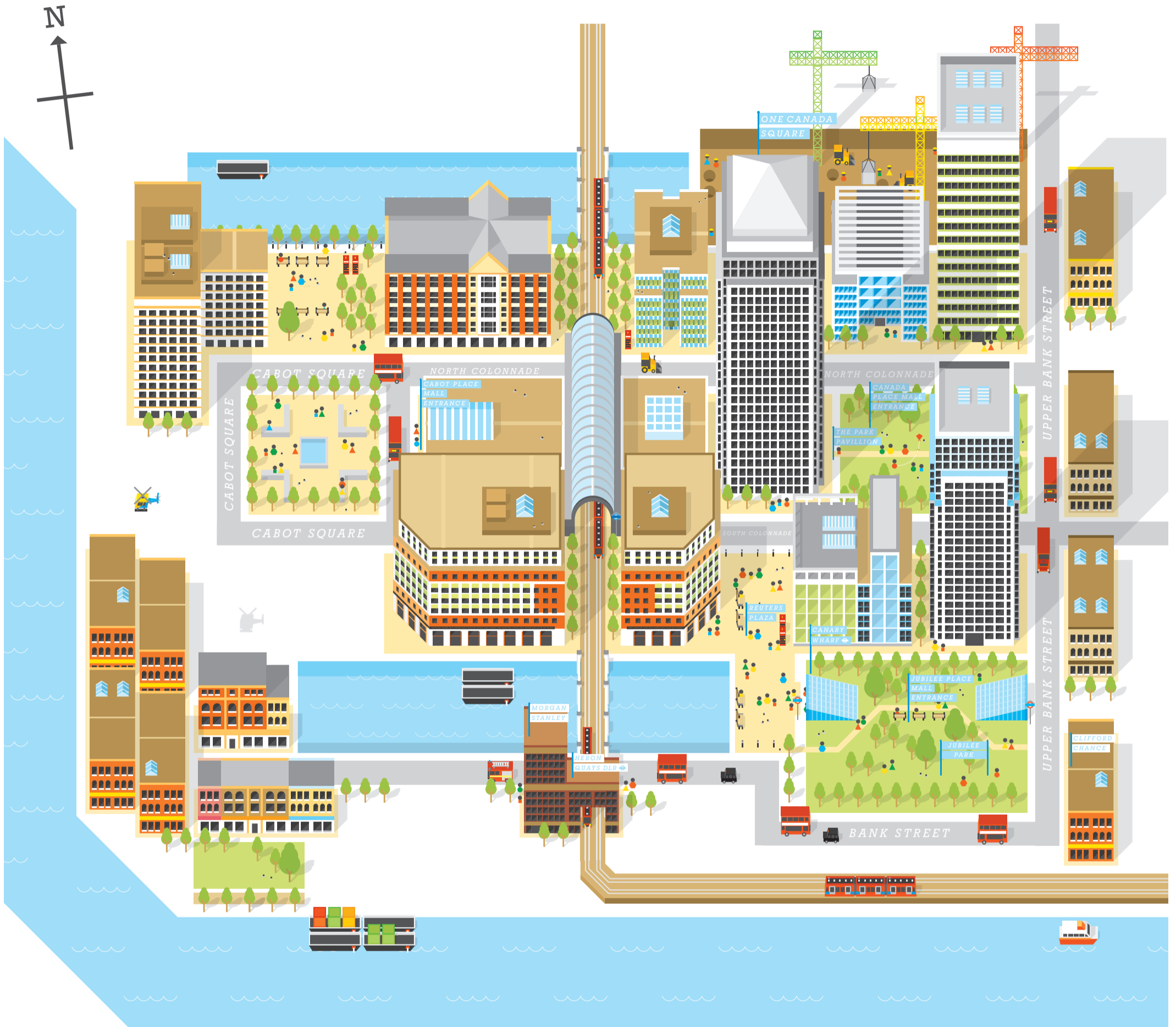


# Egg Zone 12: Canary Wharf

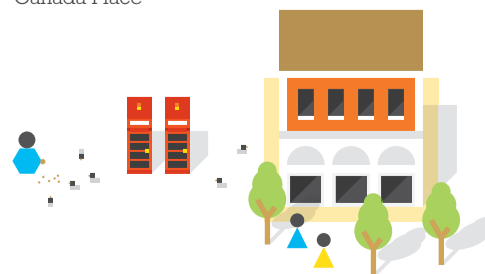
